Mike Mansfield Federal Building and U.S. Courthouse, Butte;


Missouri River Federal Courthouse, Great Falls;

Court employees will work remotely on January 19 and January 20, and all other building tenants are encouraged to direct staff to work remotely on those days to the greatest extent possible. The clerk's office will be available by telephone and accepting electronic filings via the CM/ECF system. The clerk of court is directed to establish an alternate electronic means of accepting filings from those who are unable to access the court's public filing counter on January 19 and 20.
